The Current Status of Mission Kids and Pastor Kids in HGU

In total, 689 students or 16.9% of HGU's student body are MKs and PKs. Among them, 165 or 4.0% are MKs and 524 or 12.7% are PKs. These figures are from the first semester of 2015 when there were 4,075 students.

When we consider the uncounted enrolled students or students on a leave of absence who did not reveal their status as MKs or PKs, it is expected that about 1,000 students or 25% of the whole student body may be MKs or PKs.

→ **One out of four students of HGU are MKs or PKs**

The Difficulties of MKs and PKs

In 2008 Christianity Today reported sixty percent of the exhausted missionaries who came back to Korea cited their reason to return was their children's issues.

According to Kookmin Ilbo, 2014, in the mission field, missionaries were doing their best to carry the burden of their children's education even though they struggled with their mission work due to diseases.

The major cause of termination or advances from their pension was their children's educational costs.

Within South Korea, about 2,000 or 40% churches of the Presbyterian Church in the Republic of Korea; about 4414 or 39.5% churches of the General Assembly of Presbyterian Church; about 2,225 churches of the Korean Methodist Church denomination, and about 46.9% churches of the Korea Evangelical Holiness church are non self-reliant churches according to Kookmin Ilbo, 2010.

→ **Missionaries need to focus on their mission work in the field, however, they are faced with practical difficulties such as their children's education and the associated educational costs.**

→ **Regardless its domination, 40% of Korean churches are dependent and more than 40% of the PKs attending HGU are facing financial difficulties.**

Potentials of MKs and PKs of HGU

Missionary Kids are exposed to environments where they can learn two or three languages, so they have great potential in mission work. Two thirds of MKs usually devote themselves to mission work or ministry like their parents, according to Christian Today, 2008.

70% of PKs said their vision is to become pastors like their parents. Even though they faced psychological and financial burdens as they grew up, they are still dreaming. That's why they have clear callings, according to Inbum Baek, 1990.

→ **MKs and PKs are global human talents who are familiar with multi-culture living and can speak two or three languages. 2/3 of PKs have a vision to be missionaries or pastors.**

→ **At present the MKs and PKs of HGU are one of the greatest fruits for future Korean mission work and ministry.**
